The introduction of a Tribunal application fee

From 1 July 2010 all Form 7 and 8 applications to the Residential Tenancies Tribunal must be accompanied by a \$35 fee. Applications will not be accepted without payment of the fee. The fee may be paid by cash, money order, cheque or direct debit. If paying by cheque or money order, please make payable to the Attorney-General's Department.

Full time students, concession card holders, government agencies and those able to prove hardship will be exempt from the requirement to pay the fee.
